## PVC FLOOR COVERINGS, BLANKETS AND ESSENTIAL GOODS FOR PADANG EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS

The first item in the schedule for last week's meeting was the symbolic handing over of 100 rolls (approx. 4,200 sq. m.) of PVC vinyl floor covering, blankets and essential goods for the victims of the recent earthquake in Padang, Indonesia. These items are donated by our club and other clubs in the District.

PDG Jimmy Lim, the District's roving ambassador in matters Rotary and disaster relief, provided verbal and pictorial information about this disaster and others that had happened before, having just come

back from a trip to Indonesia.

On hand to receive the donation was Ms. Soneta Asmara, a representative from the Indonesian Embassy. Also present were several journalists from New Straits Times and Bernama who witnessed the event. The supplier of the PVC material, Masfloor Sdn Bhd, was represented by Mr Benjamin Ng, its CEO, whilst the club was also happy to welcome DG Leslie Salehuddin and District Disaster Relief Chairman, PP Kulasegaran of RC Damansara to our luncheon.
